What do you think went well <u>in working with others</u>? We came up with loads of really good ideas because we got to discuss it. It gave me the confidence to work on the stall because I knew I wouldn't be on my own.

Some of the group got bored and lost interest over the three weeks.

Because we were on study leave for our mocks just before the fair, not all of the class came back to school on the day of the fair.

I helped Gem decide on the wording for the posters when she got stuck. We sat down together and came up with the right words. I helped put posters up around the school. I made posters and record cards on the computer.

How could you improve your working with others next time? (e.g. I could listen to others, plan my time better)

I could be a bit less argumentative sometimes as I think I'm always right so I don't always listen to other people's opinions. Working in a group like this helped me realise that other people have really good ideas too and I should be less stubborn.


